



Tots' Landing celebrates national accreditation

Three of Tots' Landing Learning Center locations, which offer child care, preschool and pre-kindergarten programs, have received accreditation from the National Early Childhood Program.

The company's two Murfreesboro centers and its Smyrna location earned accreditation recently, and its centers in Hendersonville and La Vergne are being reviewed now in anticipation of accreditation.

The National Early Childhood Program Accreditation is the only independent early education accrediting organization.
